(Property Description) Old Greenwood Inn was originally a hotel where the Salesmen stayed who were in Cameron to sell to the Mercantile store, McKeithen's (still existing in Cameron, now an Antiques store). The Greenwood later was a boarding house. In the basement of The Greenwood Inn The Old Saloon or Bar was a popular spot in the 1800's. In 1978, Isabel Thomas, the owner of The Greenwood turned it into an Antiques shop, the First in Cameron, and it remained as an Antiques shop through the year 2009. The building was brought up to commercial code (Electrical) in 2003. There is a small bathroom added on the porch, but no indoor plumbing. Though it needs much TLC, it is rich in history and is one of many old buildings in the quaint little town of Cameron that those who come to town to go antiquing love to visit
